The thing you must remember about First Fruits is that it was changed by the Jews shortly after Jesus raised.

I have explained how that has forever locked Jesus in as the Messiah as no one can now die on Passover and raise 3 days and nights later on First Fruits as they changed the day of FF to the first day after the first day of Passover.

The real day that it happened was the first day of the week (Sunday) after the first Sabbath (Saturday) after the first day of Passover. The way it was before they changed it.

So, Passover is the key to the understanding of the day of First Fruits.

Now, April 23/24 (Sunday) is the first day of Passover.

The first day of the week, after the first Sabbath after the first day of Passover is the following Sunday April 30/May 1.

This is not the Rapture!!!

This is the day the dead in Christ rise.

The Rapture is in fulfillment of the day that Jesus ascended into heaven taking with Him the captives that He set free from death on resurrection day - First Fruits.

Ascension Day was 40 days after First Fruits and if Passover is on April 23/24, then Rapture would be on June 9/10

All of this is of course regulated by the "abib" state of the barley.

According to my research, the first day of Passover for this year (2005) is April 23/24 - but that's why we are Watchers - we Watch!

There is no confusion - the Five Doves site writers just don't understand the feasts of the Jews and their significance to the dead rising and the rapture of the Church.
